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Weekly Assignment:

The passages below will be assigned for memorizing. Recitation will be done outside class. Lateness will not be tolerated. Absence will not be an excuse for not having passages learned and recited by the due date.

Grading: Recite to a parent or an approved adult in this way.

1)The parent will give you the passage reference and the “topic word” (example: “2 Timothy 3:16, Inspiration”).

2)The student will repeat the reference and topic word and then recite the passage word for word. Then the student will repeat the reference and topic word.

Each word is worth 1 point. Any words from the passage that are skipped, mixed up etc. will be -1 point. Words may be given as “hints” but each word given is -1 point.

If the score for a passage is less than 75% correct, that passage must be recited again after at least a period of 30 minutes. The minimum score for a passing grade is printed beside each passage in brackets. An adult must fill out and sign the recitation sheet for each passage recited.

24. **Romans 3:20**.....**Law (17/23)**

“Therefore no one will be declared righteous in his sight by observing the law; rather, through the law we become conscious of sin.

25. **Matthew 22:37-39****Summary of the Law (29/39)**

“Jesus replied: “Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.’ This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’”

26. **2 Corinthians 13:14** **The Trinity (18/24)**

“May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.”

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27. **Luke 22:19-20** ***The Lord’s Supper*** (41/55)

“And he took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, “This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me.”

In the same way, after the supper he took the cup, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you.”

28. **1 Corinthians 11:27** (NKJV)..... ***The Lord’s Supper*** (21/29)

“Therefore, whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord.”

29. **1 Corinthians 10:17** (NKJV)..... ***The Lord’s Supper*** (14/18)

“For we, *though* many, are one bread *and* one body; for we all partake of that one bread.”

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30. **Matthew 18:18-20** **The Keys** (20/26)

“I tell you the truth, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.”

31. **1 Timothy 2:11-13** **Church Leadership** (21/28)

“A woman should learn in quietness and full submission. I do not permit a woman to teach or to have authority over a man; she must be silent.”

32. **Romans 16:17** **False Teachers** (23/31)

“I urge you, brothers, to watch out for those who cause divisions and put obstacles in your way that are contrary to the teaching you have learned. Keep away from them.”

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33. **Colossians 3:16**..... **Fellowship** (26/35)

“Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom, and as you sing psalms, hymns and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God.”

34. **Hebrews 10:25**..... **Fellowship** (23/31)

“Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.”

35. **Romans 12:2 (NKJV)**..... **Sanctification** (24/32)

“And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what *is* that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.”

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36. **1 Timothy 6:6-8** **Being Content** (26/35)

“But godliness with contentment is great gain. For we brought nothing into the world, and we can take nothing out of it. But if we have food and clothing, we will be content with that.”

37. **Ephesians 4:32** **Forgiveness** (13/17)

“Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.”

38. **Ephesians 5:21** **Christian Submission** (7/9)

“Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.”

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39. **Ephesians 5:22-23**.....**Marriage** (26/34)

“Wives, submit to your husbands as to the Lord. For the husband is the head of the wife as Christ is the head of the church, his body, of which he is the Savior.”

40. **Ephesians 5:25**.....**Marriage** (12/16)

“Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her”

41. **Ephesians 5:33**.....**Marriage** (16/21)

“However, each one of you also must love his wife as he loves himself, and the wife must respect her husband.”

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42. **Proverbs 3:5-6** (NKJV)..... **Trust** (20/27)

“Trust in the LORD with all your heart,
And lean not on your own understanding;
In all your ways acknowledge Him,
And He shall direct your paths.”

43. **Philippians 2:4** (NKJV) **Thoughtfulness** (14/19)

“Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others.”

44. **Matthew 18:15**..... **Christian Discipline** (22/29)

“If your brother sins against you, go and show him his fault, just between the two of you. If he listens to you, you have won your brother over.”

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45. **2 Corinthians 9:7** *Offerings to God* (18/24)

“Each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.”

46. **1 Corinthians 16:2** *Offerings to God* (29/38)

“On the first day of every week, each one of you should set aside a sum of money in keeping with his income, saving it up, so that when I come no collections will have to be made.”

47. **2 Corinthians 5:15** *Living for Jesus* (20/26)

“And he died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died for them and was raised again.”

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48. **Romans 5:8**.....*God's Love in Christ* (14/19)
 "But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us."
49. **1 Peter 5:7** *Pray to Jesus* (8/11)
 "Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you."
50. **Matthew 11:28**.....*Jesus Gives Rest* (12/16)
 "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest."

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
